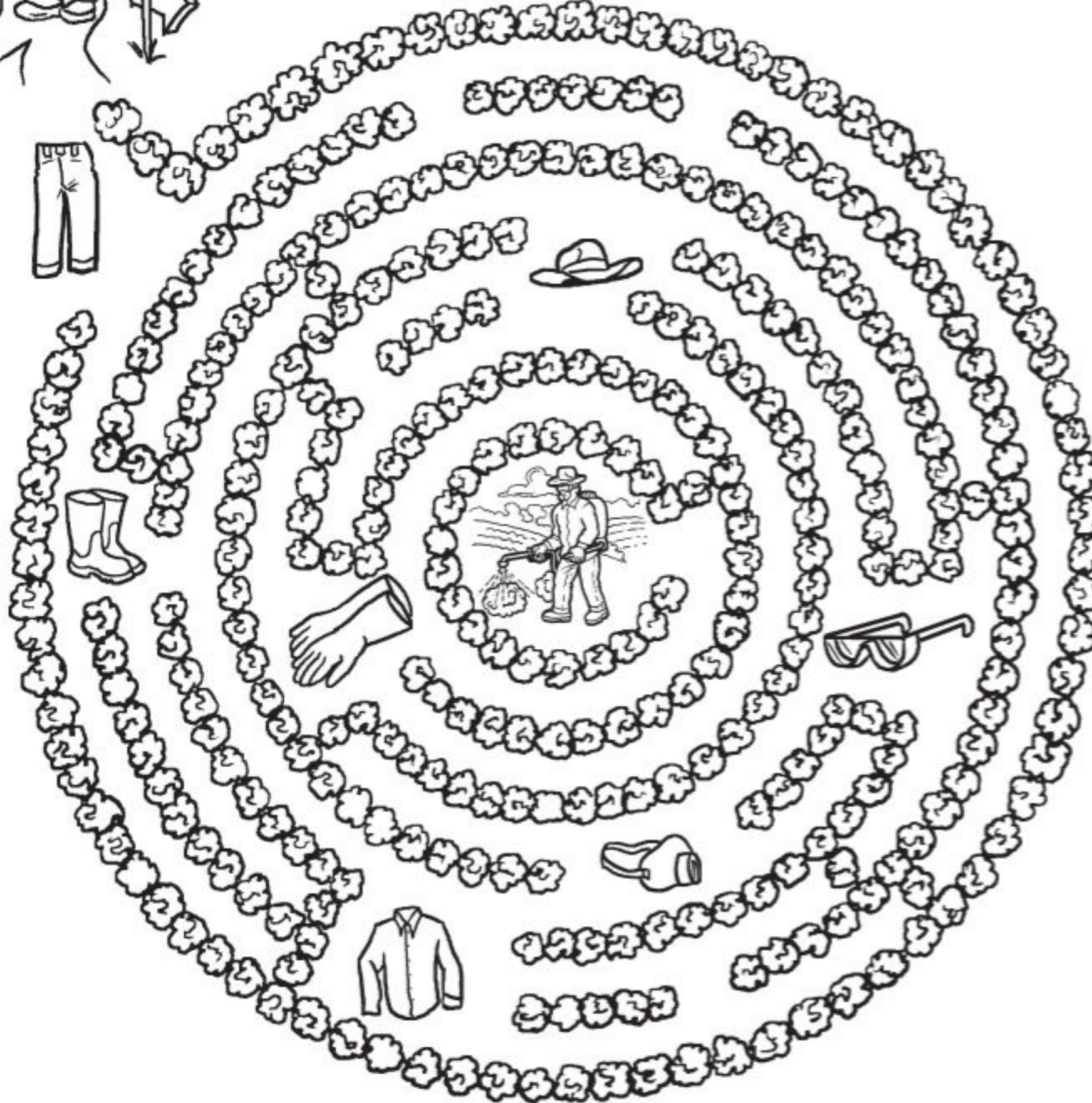

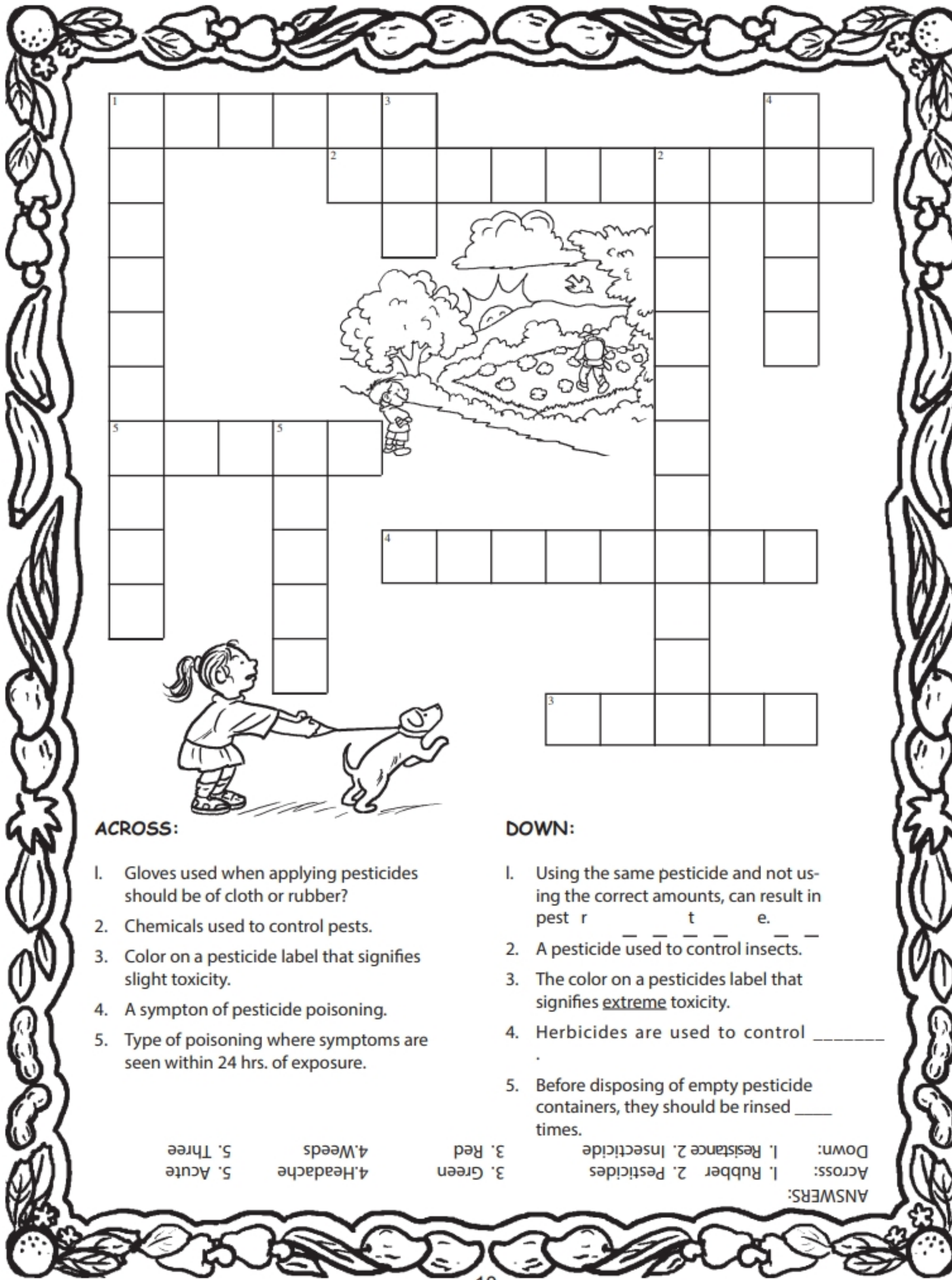

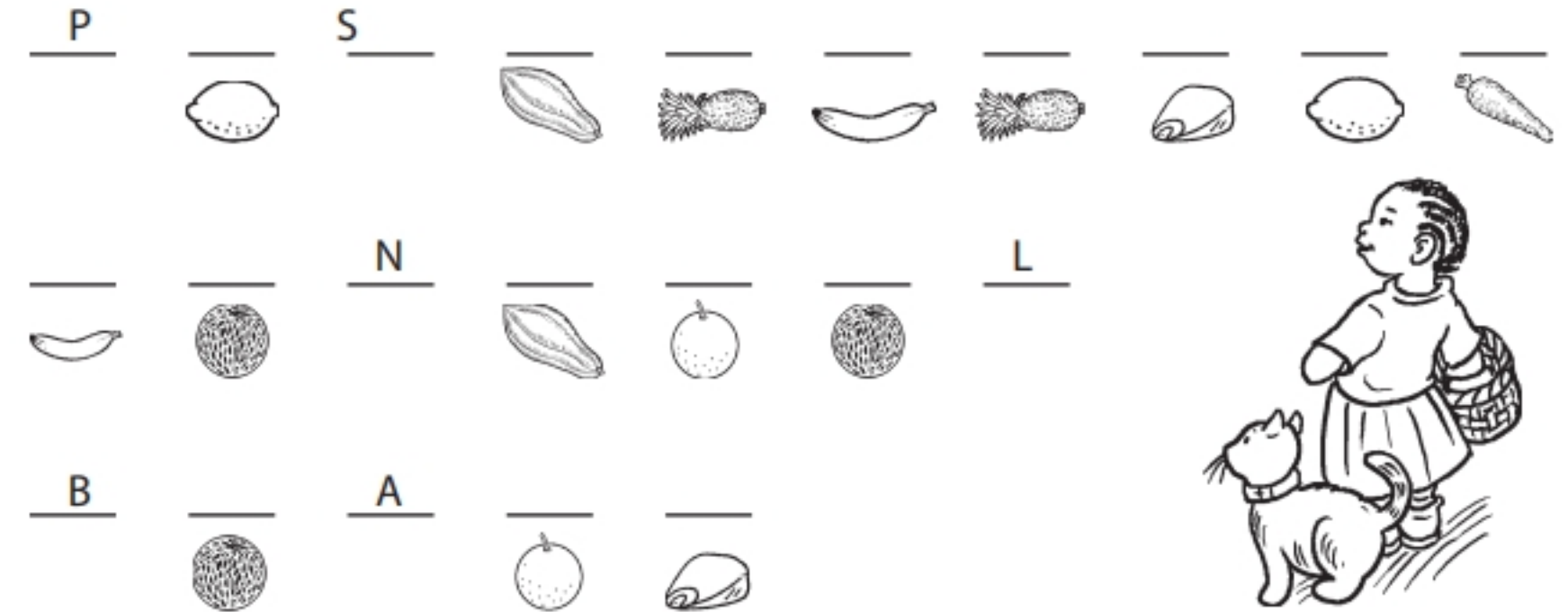
Help the farmer find his protective clothing in the maze below. Remember, before using pesticides, one must be protected to prevent poisoning.

Some Signs and Symptoms of Acute Pesticide Intoxication (Poisoning)

In Acute Pesticide Poisoning, Symptoms appear within 24 hours of exposure (or contact with the pesticide).

☐	Protection of grains in storage from storage pests.
☐	Pest Resistance (pests are no longer killed by the pesticides).
☐	Helps to prevent entry of pests and diseases from one country to another (quarantine).
☐	Contamination of water.
☐	Protects crops from pests and diseases.
☐	Treatment of buildings to protect from termites and other structural pests.
☐	Intoxication (poisoning).
☐	Controls pests that carry diseases. (Eg. mosquitos)
☐	Residues on food.
☐	Contamination of soil.
